Traveling Lite

Titan's sturdy, stylish suitcases make dropping weight a breeze

Sixteen-and-a-half-ounce tub of La Mer—check. Louboutins in every color of the rainbow—check. Umbrella, straightening iron, case of Red Bull (hey, you never know)—check, check, check. Sounds like your “just the necessities” approach to travel is really starting to weigh you down. But before you try to silence that inner hoarding instinct, take a look at Titan's U.S.-debut line of ultra-light flight bags, trolleys, laptop cases and carry-ons (previously available exclusively in Europe and Asia). Not a single piece from the German-engineered brand's four luggage collections—Xenon, 360° Four, X2 and Manhattan—exceeds 12 pounds. In fact, its scratch-resistant beauty cases (roomy enough to hold the aforementioned face cream and flat iron plus an arsenal of products) log in at just shy of 3 pounds apiece. Meaning you're much more likely to make it through check-in without those pesky overweight-baggage fees—and with your “never leave home without it” philosophy firmly intact. ■
